# PARA DRESSAGE JUDGES' GRADING SYSTEM

There are three levels to which judges may aspire:

Provincial Candidates (may judge Grades 1a, 1b and 2 with a National Judge)

Provincial Judges (may judge Grades 1a, 1b, 2 and 3)

National Judges (may judge all Grades up to and including CDN status)

By progression, each judge will have the opportunity to attain National status, and from there be given the opportunity to achieve FEI status.

### Provincial Candidates

Provincial Candidates will have achieved the following:

- Be a recognised SANEF Provincial "C" Dressage Judge
- Have attended a National Seminar for Para Dressage Judges
- Have judged Para Dressage competitions at either SARDA or SANEF level
- Have completed a written exam at a national seminar to the satisfaction of the clinicians
- Have completed a practical judging exam at a national seminar, including Grades 1a, 1b and 2, to the satisfaction of the clinicians

### Provincial Judges

Provincial Judges will have achieved the following:

- Be a qualified SANEF Provincial "B" Dressage Judge
- Have attended a national seminar for Para Dressage Judges within the past two years
- Have judged at a minimum of three Para Dressage Shows (either SARDA or SANEF level) within the past two years
- Have completed a written exam at a national seminar to the satisfaction of the clinicians
- Have completed a practical judging exam, including Grades 1a,1b, 2 and 3

to the satisfaction of the clinicians if at a national seminar, or the official judges if during a show

**National Judges**

National Judges will have achieved the following:

- Be a qualified SANEF National Candidate, National B or National A Dressage Judge
- Have attended a national seminar for Para Dressage Judges within the past two years
- Have judged at a minimum of five Para Dressage shows (either SARDA or SANEF level) including a National Championship within the past two years
- Have completed a written exam at a national seminar to the satisfaction of the clinicians
- Have completed a practical judging exam including all Grades to the satisfaction of the clinicians if at a national seminar, or the official judges if during a show

**FEI Candidate Judges**
