

## **Suggested Region qualifications**

After our GHS Reining meeting Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2010 it was decided to implement the following selection criteria

### REINING SELECTIONS

Consist of:

1. Four individual Disciplines, as follows
2. **Reining**: Youth ,lower higher
3. **Pleasure**: Youth, lower , higher
4. **Trail**: Youth ,lower , higher
5. **Horsemanship**: Youth ,lower, higher  
No cross entry between grades.
6. Any rider wishing to try qualify their horse in any one or more of the above disciplines must have ridden in the past Year (taken from closing date of entries one year back) in **two** GHS Reining , South African Reining Horse association or regional Reining shows and must have ridden in at least one Reining class per show. (No placing necessary purely a qualification for all western classes). This qualification can be at any level. Pre novice, Novice, intermediate or open.( Youth, Non Pro , or Rookie Pro)
7. A horse must qualify for each individual discipline for selection in that discipline.
8. To be eligible for selection in Reining classes the horse must have competed in any two South African Reining Horse Association, GHS Reining or Regional Reining shows. Within one calendar year from closing date of entries. In at least one reining class per show.
9. A horse must qualify for each discipline by competing in that discipline.
10. Teams as follows minimum of 2 riders and a max of 6 in all grades over all disciplines.
11. Regions at their discretion should select the highest qualified horses in each discipline. With a minimum of 2 and a max of 6 per team.
