

GHS ALL GRADE CHAMPS RULES

THE COMPETITOR

Open to all full members of the Gauteng Horse Society.

THE HORSE/PONY

Open to registered horses and ponies.

Classification of Rider

The qualification of rider is dependent on the points the rider has achieved not the horse.

Rider may only compete in their highest height category they are classified to ride in.

Once a rider has achieved 4 rider qualifying points in a level, they are then not eligible to compete in their previous level. (Eg. Rider has 4 qualifying points at 1.10m. Rider is not allowed to qualify for the 1.00m class. If rider has 3 qualifying points in 1.10m he is still qualified to compete in the 1.00m class).

Classification of Horse

Any horse may compete subject to the current SANEF grading.

Qualification for Final GHS Championships

The championships shall have all height categories

The top 20 riders of each category will be able to compete in the Finals.

The rider's qualification points for the period of 6 months before the cut-off of 30 days prior to the final Championship show (whereupon qualifiers will be published) will be used for qualification.

All registered shows are qualifying shows for the GHS Champs.

The Finals

The finals will be held over 2 competitions.

1st Competition Table A not on time 1 jump off.

2nd Competition over 2 rounds with 1 jump off to be jumped in reverse order of merit from the first class.
