A Glimpse at some of our riders competing overseas – Part 1

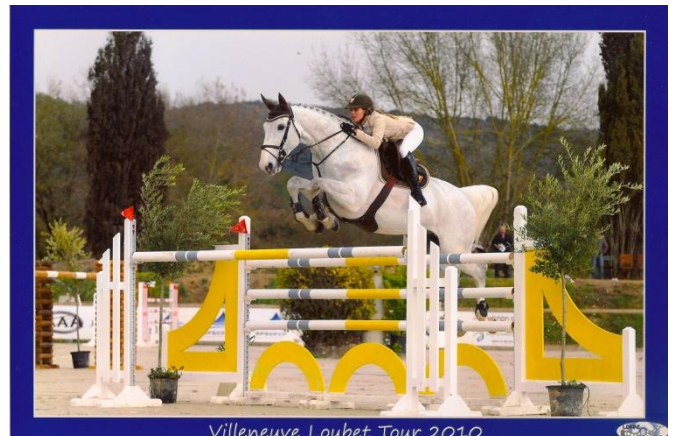
Cara Frew – Villeneuve Loubet Tour – France 2010

Cara Frew is one of our Young riders who competes regularly in South Africa as well as in Europe. Cara's horses are based in Europe with Pascal Levy. Cara recently spent 3 weeks competing on the Villeneuve Loubet Tour in France. Cara took her string of grey horses and qualified Leopold Pierreville for the 1.50 Grand Prix and had 2 down but numerous places over the 3 weeks.

Oliver Lazarus – Neustadt Dosse (GER), Sunshine Tour (ESP)

Oliver Lazarus was based with top German Showjumper Ludgar Beerbaum for the last couple of years and moved at the end of last season to another top German Olympic Medalist - Showjumper Otto Becker. Oliver has 3 of his own horses as well as horses belonging to owners. Oliver competes regularly on the Indoor and Outdoor circuit in Europe as well as the German Riders Tour. Some of Oliver's horses

Oliver also flew down to Spain to rider David McPherson's horse Silver Spring a 11 year old

Chestnut gelding by Larino and was placed 14th in the Grand Prix with 4 penalties. This was the first time Oliver had ridden this horse.

Denise Hallion – Addington Manor (UK)

Denise Hallion is based at her lovely Mayhill Stud Farm in Hampshire – England. Denise trains with well know Dressage trainer Jennie Loriston Clarke. Denise had great success last with her young horse Wervelwind in the 6 year old classes, winning the 6 year old National class at Hickstead. She has since bought a Grand Prix horse called Bomond (Stable name of Meeka) who recently competed in the Inter 1 classes at Addington Manor with a 62.5% in the first class and 64.5% in the second class taking home two 4ths. Wervelwind has qualified for the Medium Championships at the Winter National Championships. It is a big show in the UK on the 11th April.

Wervelwind = 7 year, Dark Bay, Gelding, Sire: Painted Black

Danielle and Ugolini qualified for the final Junior Championship where unfortunately they were unable to start due to Ugolini pulling a muscle. Ugolini is currently based at Stal van Decraen and Danielle will travel to Europe to compete on him
