INTER REGIONAL CRITERIA

Firstly, always remember it is an honour to be selected to represent your region, and all we want is that you show commitment to the team and other team members, and we encourage team spirit.

Choosing the **WINNING TEAM** is always a difficult process and therefore we use a few methods which we hope will make the job easier.

1. Fill in our registration form and fax it back to advancedental@yebo.co.za so that we have a record of you. (Remember not all riders are GHS registered so it makes our job a little more difficult).
2. Remember to send in your results from all the shows you attend especially the training shows. Try and attend at least two training shows in our region as we the Committee try to always have a representative at each show to scout for talent and to explain the process to the riders and their parents. Our emphasis will always be on form and consistency.
3. We also use the GHS database for graded riders. These points will carry weight especially in the higher levels.
4. Lastly, we use the points from the schools shows.

All this information is put on a database and then the long list is drawn from this.

The committee also reserves the right to identify rider/horse combinations that are in top form and have been consistent with their riding.

We will also take into account “**no shows**” i.e. any rider chosen in previous years but failed to compete or notify the committee therefore putting the team in a bad light will not be considered.

The long list will comprise of up to 8 riders (10 for showing) and the short list will comprise of 5 riders, 1 being the reserve and who will be substituted if the need arises. Showing short list will be 6 riders.

Any team rider who accepts a position in the team and fails to compete requires a valid medical or veterinary certificate, or they could face disciplinary action.

The final team selections will be at the Gauteng South committee’s discretion and the committee will try everything possible to be fair and equitable to ensure that the best horse/rider combinations are selected.
