**PRIZE MONEY** : 60% of the Net entry fee will be awarded between classes 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6 on an overall basis, subject to General Regulations 01.12.0  
**There will be a 15% deduction from the prize money which will be paid into the SANEF Driving Fund**

Dressage tests to be driven in a 100m x 40m arena and by memory for all competitors

**COMPETITION B-** for all competitors

#### **MARATHON**

Classes 1 2 3 4 & 5 OPEN -Three stage comprising section A B & E approx 14km in total with 8 hazards

Class 6 NOVICE - Single stage, comprising section E approx 8km with 8 hazards

Please note-competitors must be at least 14 years old and horses must be at least 5 years old to be eligible to compete in the marathon phase.

### **5. NOTES**

1. All classes to be run under SANEF Rules 2010

2. Entries from outside KwaZulu Natal must be countersigned/stamped by the Provincial Body concerned, as being in order.
3. Competitors shall wear protective headgear and medical band at all times whilst warming up, in the practice arena and correct dress while in the competition.
4. Wheel widths **MUST BE ENTERED IN THE ENTRY FORM**. If no wheel width is stated, the entry will not be accepted. SANEF 62.2.4
5. Protests and Appeals must adhere to SANEF General Regulations . The fees of R500 and R 600 respectively to be paid in CASH.
6. Entries not in order at closing date of entries will not be accepted and the entry fees will be refunded. Entry forms not accompanied by entry fees will not be accepted. Provincial membership must be up to date for all Classes. **NO CHANGES BETWEEN CLASSES WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES.**
7. Faxed entries will only be accepted if accompanied by a stamped deposit slip, which should clearly state Driver `s Name as reference. Proof of payment must be supplied if entry fees are paid via electronic funds transfer- use Driver's Name as reference, and use the show secretary's e-mail address
8. Any requests for a specific Driving order must be clearly indicated in the entry form. Please see Driving Rules 62.8.3 The draw for driving order will be done in accordance with the SANEF Driving Rules.
9. It is the responsibility of the competitor to make sure the entries have been received. All dressage tests used are from the official SANEF/FEI Dressage Tests for Driving -2010
10. The Show Holding Body reserves the right to alter or vary the programme in light of prevailing conditions at their discretion, with the approval of the Technical Delegate.
11. The Organizing Committee, the Show Holding Body, KZNHS, SANEF, HACS KZN and Brinstone Farm or any of their officials cannot be held liable for any loss, damage, death or injury to people, horses or property whatsoever. All competitors and spectators enter the premises entirely at their own risk.

12. **STRICTLY No dogs allowed on or off leads**
13. The Marathon course will be open for inspection on foot from 14h00 on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> November. As from the closing date of entries, no competitor/ competing horse may ride/drive in the vicinity of the marathon hazards, until called upon to do so, under penalty of elimination.
14. **Numbers are to be collected at Registration and are to be displayed/worn for all 3 phases.**
15. Competitors please note that Medical cards are compulsory and must be clearly visible on the driver preferably on the arm. Medical cards and holder can be purchased at R30.00 and collected when you get your numbers. Please indicate and pay with your entry.
16. Parking in designated areas only.

18. Please note: Private stables, yards, lunge rings and paddocks are out of bounds.
19. All stallions must have a yellow disc on both sides of the bridle or have a yellow ribbon on the tail.  
**VETERINARY.**
20. **Equine flu vaccinations must be administered within 6 months of the date of event.**
21. The AHS vaccinations must be administered within 12 months of the date of the event. All vaccinations must be administered by a veterinarian. Any medication administered within 14 days prior to the event must be administered by a veterinarian and the relevant SANEF Form completed and presented at the event.
22. **PASSPORTS.**  
Please note that only FEI and SANEF passports are acceptable when registering horses/ponies for affiliated/graded competitions. All horses are required to hold passports. Gov Regs

**THE COMPETITOR UNDERTAKES NOT TO BRING ANY HORSE TO THE SHOW WHICH HAS AN INFECTIOUS DISEASE, WHETHER NOTIFIABLE OR NOT, OR WHICH HORSE THE COMPETITOR COULD REASONABLY BE EXPECTED TO**

**KNOW HAS INFECTIOUS DISEASES OR MAY SPREAD AN INFECTIOUS DISEASE. THE COMPETITOR UNDERTAKES TO WITHDRAW THE HORSE FROM THE EVENT (WITH FORFEITURE OF ENTRY FEE), IF SUBSEQUENT TO ENTRY IT SHOULD DEVELOP, OR SHOULD CIRCUMSTANCES ARISE UNDER WHICH THE COMPETITOR CAN REASONABLY BE EXPECTED TO KNOW WHAT THE HORSE HAS DEVELOPED OR MAY DEVELOP, ANY SUCH DISEASE OR ABILITY TO SPREAD SUCH A DISEASE.**
