

Qualification for the Lower and Higher Grade interregional

is recommended that a horse rider needs to have competed in two shows, by the closing date of entries.

TEAM RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Teams will be selected from the new **Pre novice and Novice horse category only**. Higher grade selections will be from Intermediate and open horse only.

Lower Grade

A total team to consist of minimum of **two** Horse and rider combinations, with a maximum of **Eight** horses/rider combination from all rider age groups Over all the disciplines. In each **discipline(class)** a minimum of **one** rider and a maximum of **two**. I.e. Pleasure may have one rider or two riders, etc. the same rider may compete in all four disciplines if qualified for these discipline. A rider may ride one horse in the team.

Higher Grade

A total team to consist of minimum of **two** Horse and rider combinations, with a maximum of **Eight** horses/rider combination from all rider age groups Over all the disciplines. In each **discipline(class)** a minimum of **one** rider and a maximum of **two**. I.e. Pleasure may have one rider or two riders, etc. the same rider may compete in all four disciplines if qualified for these discipline. A rider may ride one horse in the team.

All lower grade riders will compete in western tack and dress in a snaffle or Shank 1 or 2 handed.

- All Higher grade riders will ride in either snaffle two handed or Shank one handed
- GHS and SANEF rules apply
- All Lower grade riders and horses must be registered (entry Level accepted) with regional body
- All Higher grade Horses and Riders must have Full Regional or Reining Membership .
- Reining patterns can be found on GHS Reining website.
- No martingales, whips, nosebands or tie downs will be allowed
- Youth Lower Grade (under 18) must compete in a helmet
- Youth Higher grade may ride in Stetson with written permission from parent or legal guardian.
- Youth will be allowed to ride in a snaffle or Shank bit 1 or 2 hands
All riders must start the class with the same hand or hands they started the class with no change of hands during the class will be allowed.
- Youth is defined as any rider 18 years old and younger
