2011 Horse Of the Year

Below are the CVs for some of the judges judging at the 2011 Horse of the Year

Allister Hood

Allister Hood is an internationally recognized judge of Hacks, Hunters and Breed horses. He lives on the Norfolk border where he runs a showing yard with his son Oliver. Alisterhas produced top show horses for over twenty-five years and has ridden champions at all the major shows in the United Kingdom. He believes that showing is an excellent way of producing multi-talented horses and that a Champion Show Horse is one that loves being in the ring.

Loraine Homer

Loraine homer was born into one of the most successful showing families in England, only daughter of David Tatlow and grand daughter of Harry Tatlow. She rode for her country as a child and progressed into horse competitions at an early age.

Loraine has won many major showing competitions in England and also has a good business, buying, breaking and selling show horses to other professional producers. She is on all horse and pony judging panels and has judged at most of the top county shows including the Royal International, royal Windsor and Horse of the Year show.

David Dixon

David comes from an Eventing background. He judges often in the UK and has also judged at Royal Show - New Zealand, Barrastoc- Australia and Sweden

He will be judging the National Hunter Show in the UK in 2011

He is the owner of the 2009 U.K. Hack of the Year - Baydale Venus and is a breeder of Hacks, Riding Horses and Hunters.
